Sobriquets - It's Meaning and ORIGIN -

Sobriquet is a French word. Sob means - foolish, briquet -a french adaptation.

Sobriquets are familiar names or an assumed name, a fanciful epithet, a nickname for a person often a shortened version of a person's given name. It is a pseudonym assumed as a disguise, but a nickname which is familiar enough such that it can be used in place of a real name without need of explanation. eg. Abraham Lincoln - **Honest Abe** , Pamirs - **Roof of the world**, Kerela - **Spice Garden of India**, Bhutan - **Land of Thunderbolt**.
