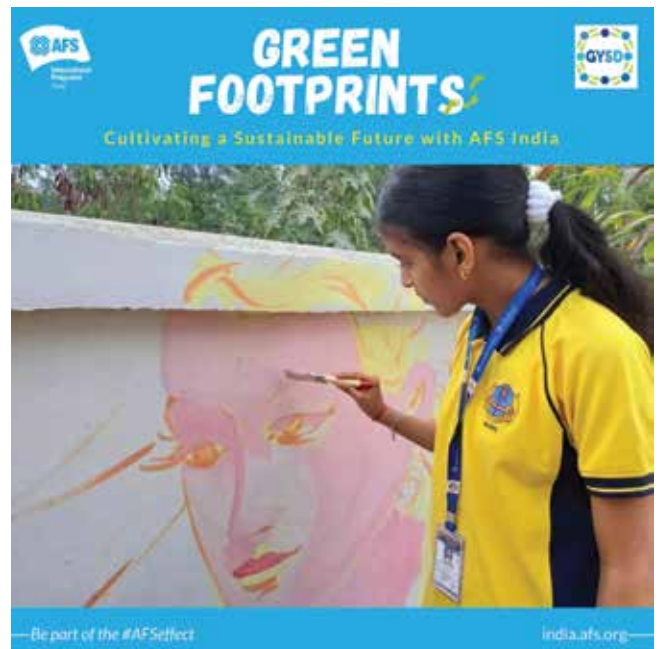
As the sun sets on our Summer Camp, we reflect on the memories made, the bonds formed and the magic experienced. Here's to a day filled with joy,

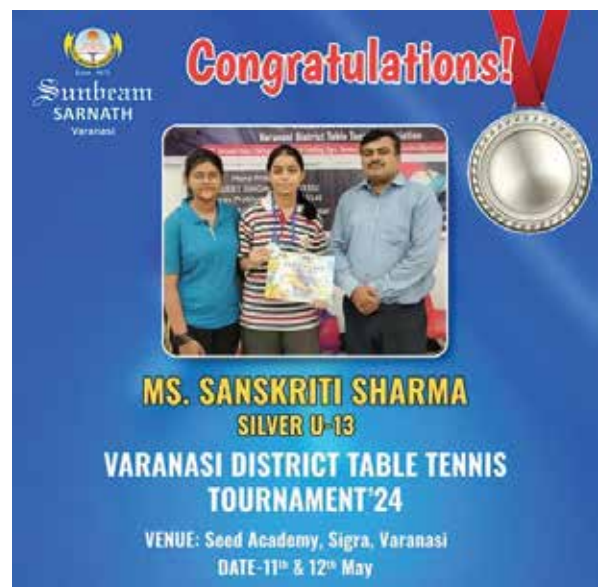
Open State Taekwondo Championship 2024
