The "Haasya Rasa" was based on the manic obsession for mobile phones and how technology rules our life.

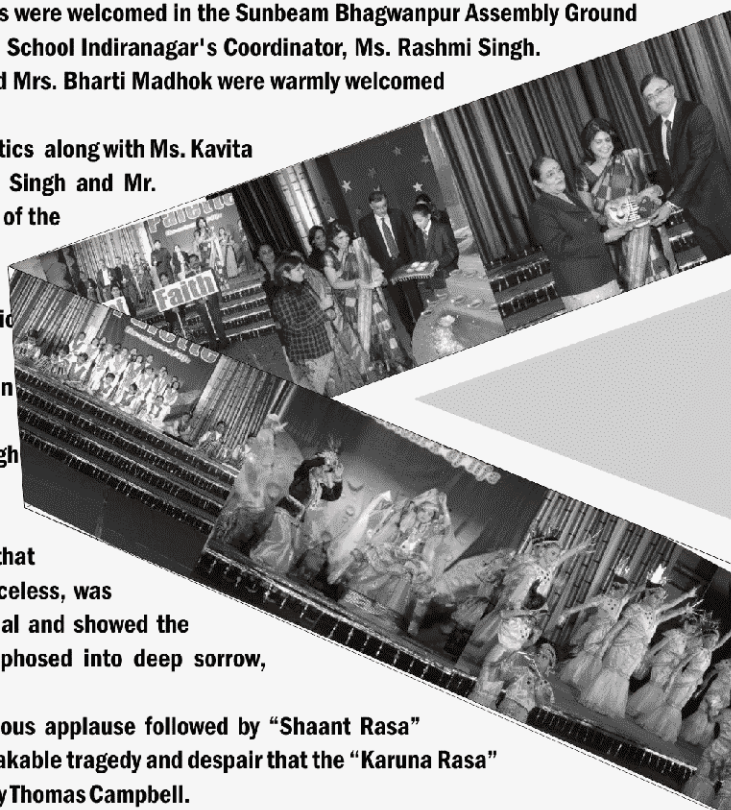
