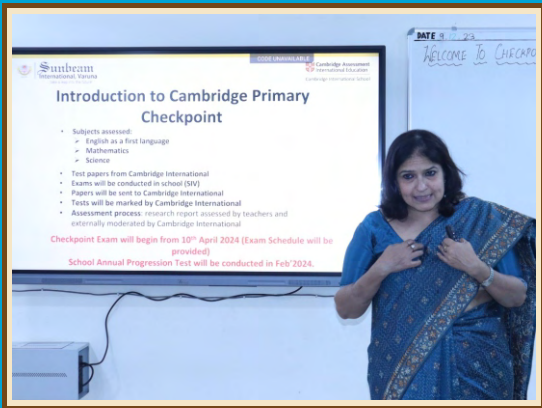

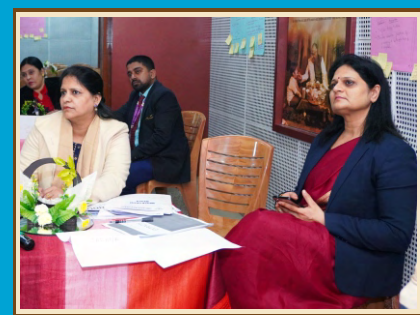
Empowering Pedagogues : Inspiring Dialogues

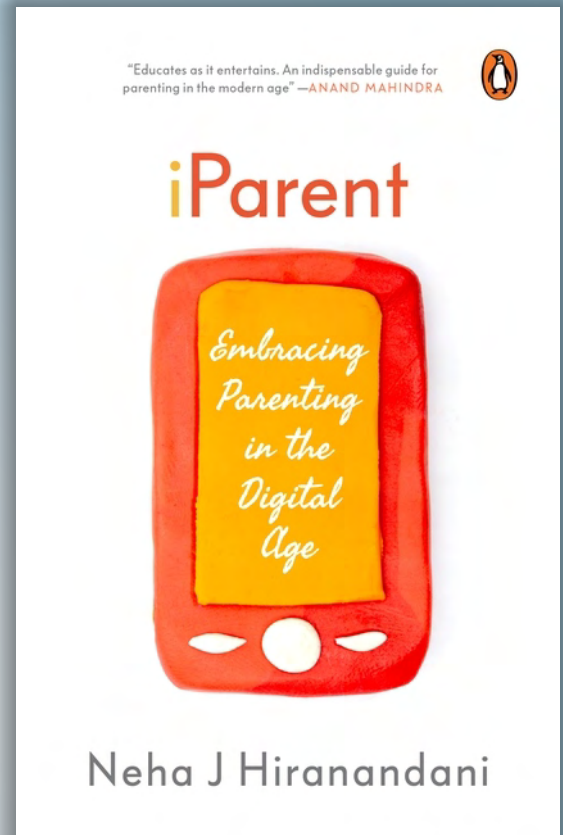
