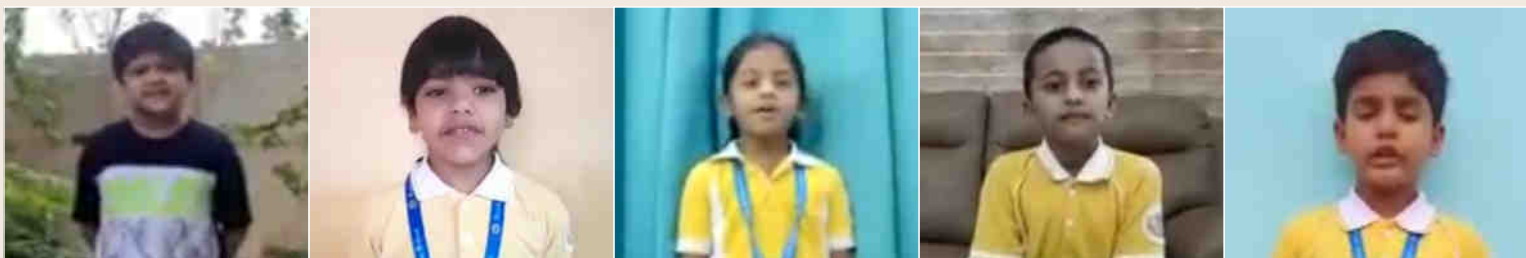

Overall the two day Professional Visit Programme enlightened the students with new ray of hope and way ahead in these trying times.

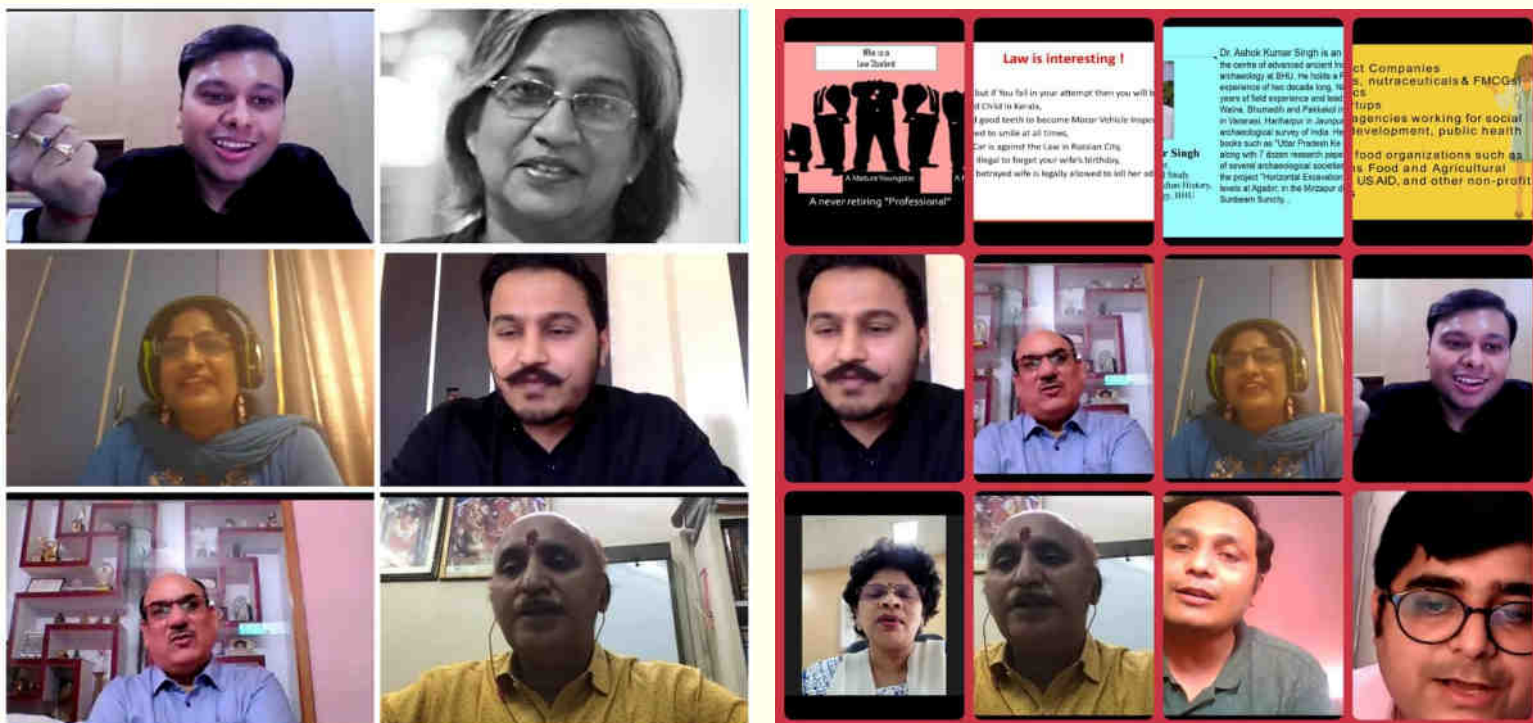

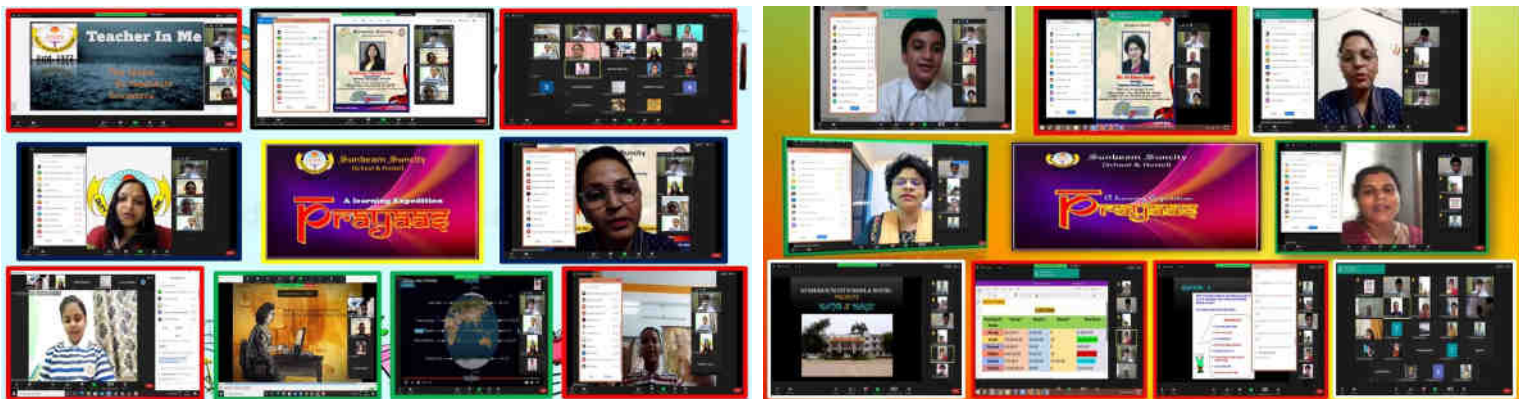

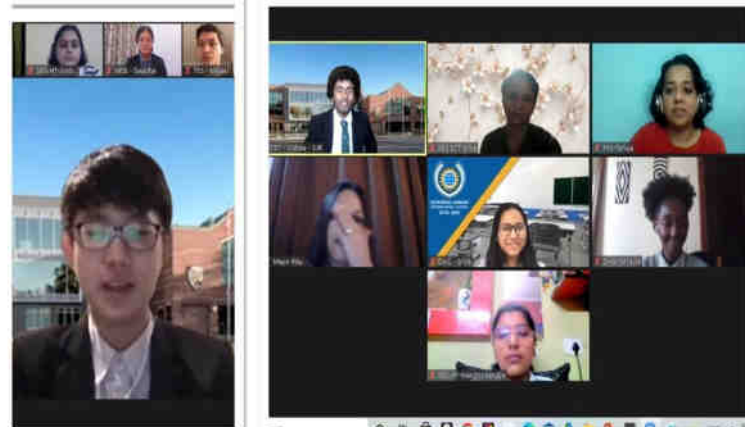
RS Postcard organised by St. John's Ravenscourt in Canada on "Be the difference: Mental health and happiness"



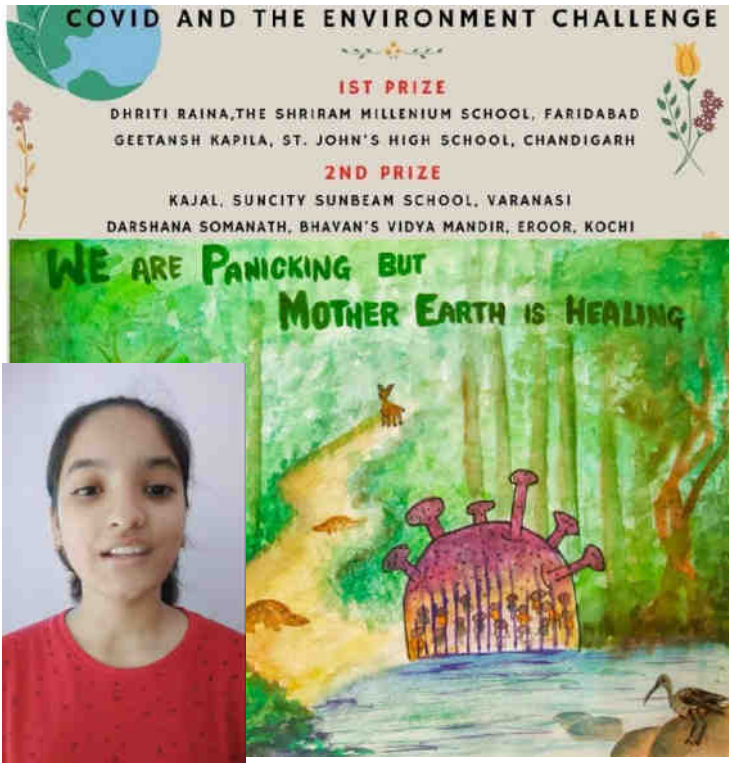

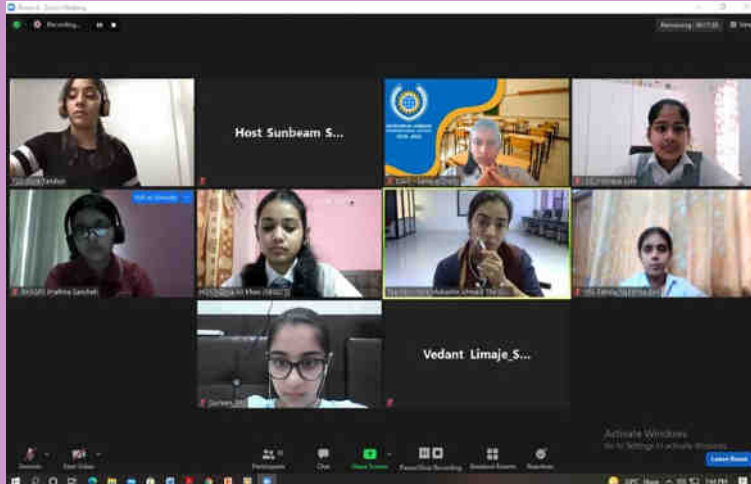
'Footprints on the sand'.

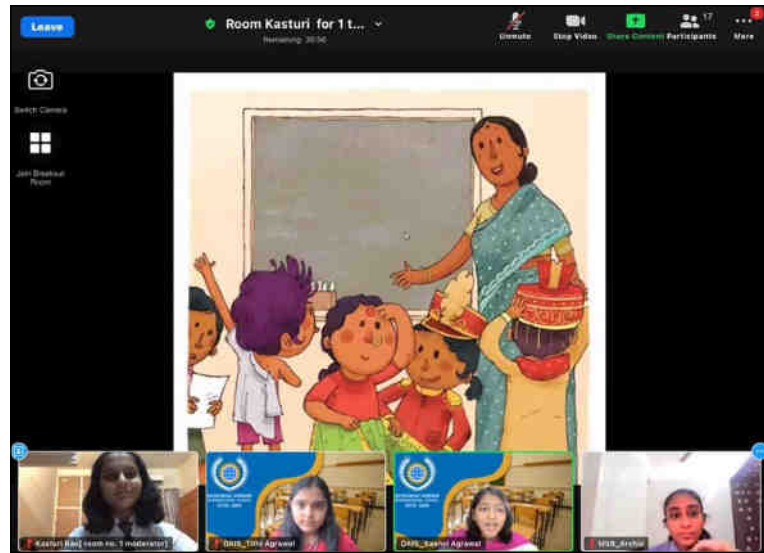
'ONCE UPON A TIME' storytelling collaboration

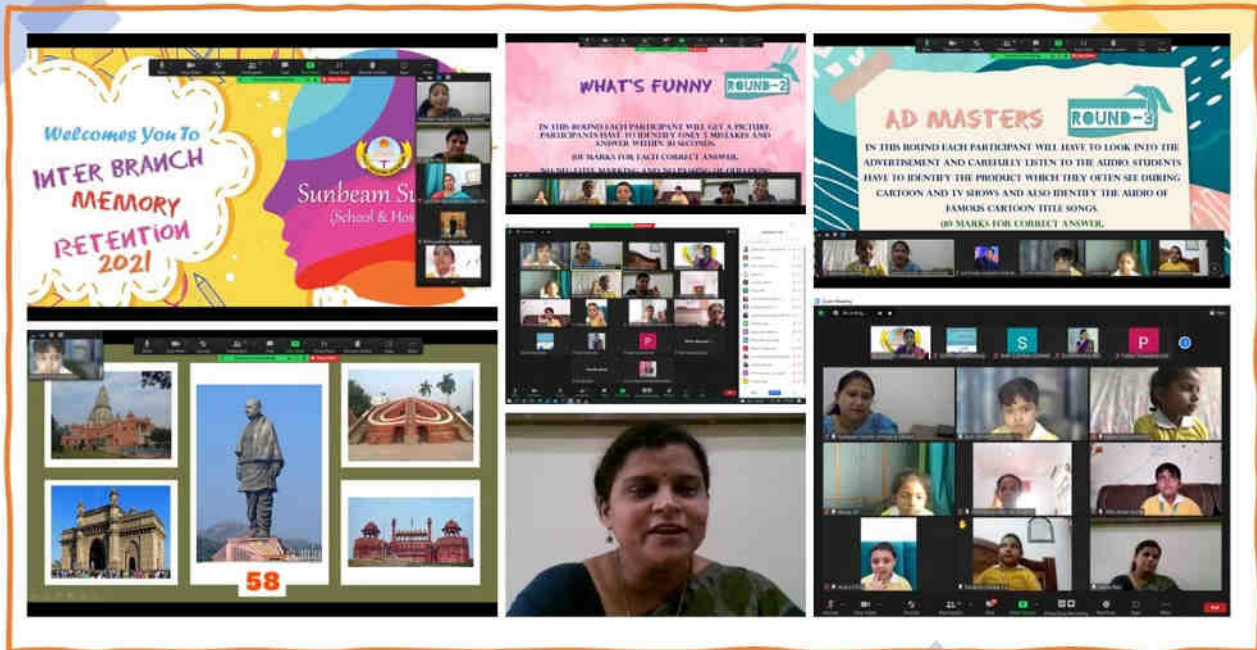

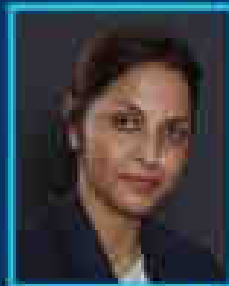
