There were a number of people in the audience, who were well versed with the episodes of Valmiki or Tulsi Ramayana, and therefore sought explanation from Amish for his character sketch of Sita as he presented in his book, which is apparently very different from the known scriptures.

The program, began with felicitations of the two personalities, by the Chairman and Director of Sunbeam Group – Mr. Deepak Madhok & Mrs. Bharti Madhok, after which the Honorary Director – Mr. Harsh Madhok extended his welcome note to the special guests and the audience.
